Aren Sparck, MUP is the Government Affairs Officer at the Seattle Indian Health Board (SIHB), a private, non-profit IHS Urban Indian Health Program that offers comprehensive primary and behavioral health services with a mission is to serve the American Indian/Alaska Native (AI/AN) population in Seattle and King County

Aren is Cup'ik, from western Alaska. He received his Masters in Urban Planning from the University of Washington and a BA in Geography from George Washington University.

Aren sits on the American Indian Health Commission (AIHC) of Washington State's Executive Committee as a delegate for both the SIHB and The NATIVE Project in Spokane. He also represents the AIHC on Washington State's Health Benefit Exchange Board Advisory Committee. Aren serves as the SIHB's representative to the State of Washington's Indian Policy Advisory Committee, the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services Tribal Technical Advisory Workgroup and the National Indian Health Board's Medicare, Medicaid and Health Reform Policy Committee. Aren sits on the Board of Directors for the Chief Seattle Club, a homeless AI/AN social service, and was recently appointed by Governor Inslee to the Health Innovation Leadership Network.
