

What will happen to AI/AN enrollees' current behavioral health care coverage on July 1, 2017?

American Indian/Alaska Native (AI/AN) enrollees who are currently receiving all of their physical health care and behavioral health care coverage through a Fully Integrated Managed Care plan will **not** see any change.

For all other AI/AN enrollees, their behavioral health care coverage will be changed to the Medicaid fee-for-service program – unless they choose the managed care option available to them.

What do AI/AN Medicaid enrollees need to do to make sure they can choose their behavioral health coverage?

They need to self-identify as AI/AN with Medicaid. They can do this in one of the following ways:

Medicaid does not require tribal affiliation or proof of AI/AN status.
