The **FPHS Lifecourse Subject Matter Expert (SME) Workgroup** exists as one of several workgroups tasked with providing subject-specific recommendations and consultation to the FPHS Steering Committee.

The *Lifecourse Framework* addresses the interplay of risk and protective factors throughout the lifespan that contribute to health disparities. Interventions during the lifecourse focus on a timeline (different points over the entire lifespan), timing (critical or sensitive periods where change can best be made) and the community context where risk factors occur.

Participation is available to all professionals from any of the four aspects of the Washington State governmental public health system (State Dept. of Health, State Board of Health, Tribes, and Local Health Jurisdictions).
